

Caddie Guidelines

1. Carry your player's bag and enjoy your time walking with them.
2. Get to know all of the players and caddies in your group.
3. You may help players look for their golf ball, determine distance to the hole, rake bunkers, fix divots in fairways, repair ballmarks on greens, and remove/replace the flagstick on the green.
4. After every hole, write down the scores of your player and the player he/she is keeping score for.
5. Help your player with making strategies and decisions in a timely manner.
6. Encourage your player after both good and bad shots, and make sure he/she is having fun.
7. If a caddie becomes disruptive to the point of receiving a formal complaint from an official, volunteer, competitor or caddie, he or she will be given a warning upon validation by Front 9 Tour Official.
8. After a **second offense**, the caddie will be placed on probation and the player will be assessed a 1 stroke penalty.
9. Upon a **third offense**, caddie will be suspended for the rest of the current round and the next round.
10. **Repeat offenders** may be subject to an indefinite suspension of caddie privileges at the discretion of Front 9 Tour.

Violations include profanity, abusive language, club throwing, cheating, disrespect of volunteers, competitors, or officials, abuse to the golf course or the facilities, littering, or any other conduct unbecoming of a caddie. **Front 9 Tour reserves the right to dismiss any caddie at any time for an egregious offense.**
